



Protan Vinyl Wall Covering

Protan Vinyl wall covering is a specially developed and structured wall covering designed for flexible fittings in modern office environment systems. Available in a wide range of colours and surface structures, Protan Vinyl wall covering opens up many ways of meeting aesthetic and functional requirements at the same time.

Flexible system fittings are used more and more frequently in new office designs, and provide great advantages at the new building stage as well as in later adaptations. Changing office requirements call for flexible office solutions, and besides, flexible fittings can easily be adapted to individual needs and tastes.

Wall modules are papered with Protan Vinyl wall covering at the factory, so they are complete on arrival at the building site. Using prefabricated building materials ensures a short building process, reducing the amount of waste and the need to work with plaster and fillers during building.



Technical Details

Protan Vinyl wall covering consists of a base layer of 80 g paper with a hard-wearing PVC surface, giving a total weight of about 300 g/m². As wall covering it complies with the current DIN-requirements for stretch strength, tearing strength and wear. Protan Vinyl wall covering is highly resistant to light and is at the same time approved for fire resistance in compliance with Nordtest 004.

Protan Vinyl wall covering is type approved according to Sitac 1422 surface class 1, glued on a non-flammable base or plasterboard (SINTEF/ NBL), and it withstands most common household chemicals, detergents and soaps. The wall covering is also maintenance free.

Colours and structures

Protan Vinyl wall covering is available in all NCS colours and a number of different structures. This offers many possibilities for designing an attractive modern working environment.

Environment

Protan AS holds the international ISO 14001 environment certificate and is inspected every year by Det norske Veritas.

Protan Vinyl wall covering contains none of the chemicals included on the Norwegian Pollution Control Authority (SFT) list of chemicals which are prohibited or must be phased out. Waste products can be deposited or burnt at approved refuse disposal plants. The waste gases are quite insignificant. When a wall element is painted (plaster board + card + Protan Vinyl wall covering) gas quantities given off are below 0.02 mg./m³ at normal room temperatures.

Prefabricated room dividers contribute to effective exploitation of resources, since there is very little waste in production, at the building site or during specifically adapted transport. When the building is refurbished, many of the materials can be re-used.
